Welcome to Ben, Emily & Lucas



Hello! My name's Ben and I'm going to be the new curate at All Saints and St Mary's. Me and my family (my wife Emily and my son Lucas) have just moved into the area and are really looking forward to beginning work and seeing what God has in store for us as I prepare to be ordained on July 2nd, please do be praying for me and all others who are following this calling to priesthood.

Following a call to ordination has been a big turning point in my life. I come from Durham, where I have just finished training at Cranmer Hall, but I spent most of my life growing up in Chester Le Street. My mother became a Christian when I was very young so some of my earliest memories as a child are us attending church as a family and I quickly became a regular at the Sunday school as well as attending services.

It was here that a call toward ordination in my future was first brought up as the vicar at that time prophesised that one day I too would become a vicar.

Now being a kid at that time I didn't really know what that meant but I did understand that God had a plan for my life, something that he wanted me to do. I knew that God had a purpose for me.

That moment always stuck with me, but I had this thought in my mind that this calling wasn't for now, but sometime in the future. So, whilst it stuck with me, it was always in the back of my mind as I waited for a later date.

As the years passed and I became a teenager, we started hopping around different churches for various reasons and there was another moment where this calling was again prophesised to me, further cementing this idea that God was going to use me for something in the future. However it wouldn't be long until I started to drift away from the faith, as I neared the end of my time in school, went through sixth form, and started employment in a local pub.

To be honest with you this was a time in my life when I felt completely lost and without purpose. I felt like I had missed out on going to university and was therefore behind the rest of my peers, needing to catch up to them but not knowing how.

I was also in a job that I struggled to get any joy out of and slowly this feeling that I was going nowhere in my life slowly started to sink into my brain. I was not in a good place.

But it was here when I truly encountered God. Walking home late one night I heard the voice of God reach out and tell me to pray, something that I hadn't really done for so long. This voice was so overwhelming and sure that I knew there was nothing else I could do but pray. So I did. I prayed walking home in the dark and poured out my soul to God. All of my fears, worries and anxieties, and I kept on doing that every day, slowly building back up that pattern of regular prayer, knowing that God was listening to me.

As I prayed more, I started to study my bible again and then eventually found myself attending church once more, where I started to feel like I belonged to a church family, finding support and encouragement from so many faithful Christians. From there this calling that had been placed on my life from such a young age finally came to the forefront of my mind and I knew it was time to begin exploring what that call meant. I spoke to my vicar who affirmed that calling on my life and I began the process of working towards ordination.

For me it took about 4 and a half years as I spent a year or so on a ministry experience scheme (where I met my wife on one of the training days), in Sunderland before beginning formal training at Cranmer Hall It has at times felt overwhelming and scary, but God has met me in those moments every time and assured me of his faithfulness and steadfast love for me, and for all of us. He has called me, and He will not leave me.

That's a very brief rundown of how I got here so if you want to know more please do come and ask me and I'll be happy to share more of my time in Sunderland and at Cranmer too. God has a purpose for us all and following that purpose has changed my life for the better and I can't wait to see the exciting work he will do (and already is doing) in this church.

We have this little cross that lives in our sitting room and it's been in my head the entire time I've been writing this. It says, 'as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord', Joshua 24:15. We look forward to the ways we will serve God whilst here, knowing just how faithful and good God is
