News from Anne, one of our Church Wardens

I previously featured in the newsletter in November 2020 when Karen Killick organised a question-and-answer interview with me when I officially started my term as Church Warden. Unofficially I had shadowed Martin and Karen several months earlier. Three years on I have been asked to comment about my personal experience as warden because I will not be standing for re-election next April.

The first year as warden was far from easy because All Saints was in vacancy and Covid19 reigned. In a strange way though I enjoyed the challenge, with the help of others, of ensuring that the church family was kept connected by various means, informed of the latest Covid 19 restrictions and safe when they were eventually permitted to return to the building. When Matt was appointed in March 2021 life became much easier because I was released from the extra duties I had taken on. Involvement with the day to day running of the Church and getting a true picture of what actually takes place behind the scenes has been great. It has been a wonderful opportunity and a privilege to serve both God and you in this way and to get to know a greater number of members than I would have done if I had remained just part of the congregation.

You may be wondering what a warden does? Well, the three main areas of responsibility are to ensure the buildings and grounds of the church are kept in good repair. A duty to care and pray for the vicar, ensuring the vicar takes time off, plus have a concern for his/her family. And lastly and importantly to share a vision of the church's life and mission.

On election, a warden automatically becomes a member of the PCC and Standing Committee which means attending two separate meetings in the evening once a month. In addition, there is a fortnightly wardens' meeting currently held in the morning.
