Getting Ready For Easter

It's a good month to look in the mirror. The build up to Easter has always been about that. Not in the sense, thank goodness, of getting on the scales etc. But in the sense of having a good look at ourselves, how we are living, and making some adjustments. Traditionally Easter was the time many people would get baptised. They would use the build-up period called Lent as preparation time, to get their lives in order and to ask God for help to change.

We have just come back from a trip to Rievaulx Abbey today . It was great. If you haven't been I'd recommend it. I was really struck by an information board by one of the ruined rooms which showed the monks sitting around all together in a sort of circle. What were they doing?



They were telling each other about the changes they wanted to make, the things they kept doing that they wished they didn't and praying for one another. What love they must have had for each other and what a sense of security to be able to share what they were working on in their own lives without fearing they would be judged. What a community they must have been. I know for myself though, where I have found courage to sit with someone I trust and tell them what I am working on in my life, my aims and failings, there is such freedom brought by those conversations. You might try it.

As well as looking in the mirror to try and see where we are up to in working on our character etc, we might also have a think about how God might see us. We know God isn't delusional, he sees the good and the bad in me. He doesn't pretend. But we also know he sees something else



Michaelangelo was once asked about his sculpting process. He said 'I saw the angel in the marble and carved until I set him free'. God sees potential in us. He sees us as only he can remake and change us. He sees us without our insecurities, pride etc. He sees us through the things that need chipping off us. And he loves us

So as you look in the mirror to think about changes you want to make as you prepare for Easter, take some time to ask God how he sees you. What he wants to sculpt you into if you let him.

Have a brilliant month. Do come along to the Murder Mystery on the 21st and do set aside some time to get ready to celebrate Jesus as we approach Easter.
