A few fun facts about me is that I love to sing, I love puzzles, and I love to read. Some may call me an old soul! I love all things Jesus, adventure, and serving!

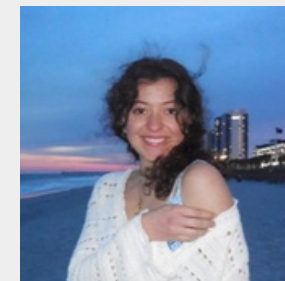
